
Kodak Plus-X Pan Film(PX) + D-76(1:1)

This film is medium-speed panchromatic films that are good choices for general-purpose photography. The characteristic curve has sharp curve at the shadow part of the fugure (lower left), and shoulder slightly at the highlight part (upper right). That is, tone of shadow part is hard and highlight is soft. Printing to General-use paper, such as *Oriental New Seagull* and *Ilford Multigrade*, you will obtain naturally black to white gradations image, because those papers have hard highlight tone and soft shadow tone.

And then, Capacity of D-76 diluted 1:1 is only one 135-36 roll in 473 mL (16 ounces, double-reel tank). If you process one 135-36 roll in a 237 mL (8-ounce, single-reel) tank or two 135-36 rolls in a double-reel tank, increase the development time by 10-15 percent.
